

## **Volunteer Information Sheet**

There are multiple levels of involvement possible with Pathfinders. Here are some of the options.

### **Counselor:**

Counselors are asked to be at Pathfinders' scheduled meetings, including staff meetings. A counselor helps with supervision and provides guidance to the kids. Each counselor has a specific unit of kids assigned for him or her to work with.

Counselors are also expected to come on campouts and most other scheduled events to help with supervision and join in the fun times. If able to help provide transportation, this is even better. If a counselor wishes, they can also possibly teach a craft, otherwise they would help with supervision at a craft another staff or community member is teaching.

### **Craft Instructor:**

Craft nights are held approximately every other week and so this level of involvement does not pull as much scheduled time as being a counselor would. Of course there still may be some craft preparation time needed outside of the regularly scheduled craft nights.
